Microsoft Copilot

Microsoft 365 Copilot for phone without transcription

Users can utilise Copilot's features during live call sessions without saving transcripts or audio recordings. This allows users to benefit from Copilot in situations where no lasting record is required.

Podcast style audio overviews for OneDrive docs

Microsoft 365 Copilot will soon provide AI-generated audio summaries for Word, PDFs and Teams meeting transcripts that are saved in OneDrive. Helping you to save time and listen to the overviews instead of reading through the whole document.

View your organisation's prompts in the redesigned Copilot Prompt Gallery app soon

You will now see a redesigned Copilot Prompt Gallery app with a new home page and updated browsing experience. Additionally, you can create, publish, and manage prompts tailored to your organisation's needs.

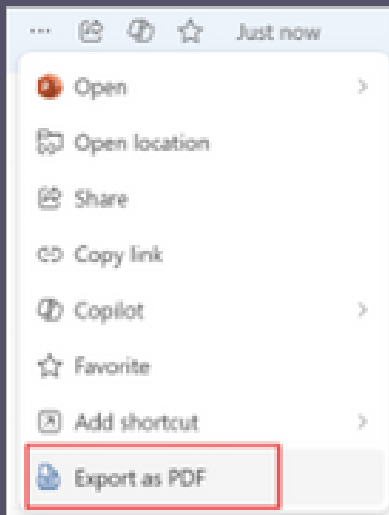

OneDrive: Export files as PDF

After this rollout, users can access the Export as PDF command in the three-dot menu or the command bar for files and shared libraries in OneDrive .



OneDrive: Prompt to Add Personal Account to OneDrive Sync

This feature prompts users who are signed into a personal Microsoft account on a Windows device and actively using their corporate OneDrive to also sign into OneDrive with their personal account.

Once signed in, users can access both their personal and corporate OneDrive accounts on the same device—without merging content. The prompt is enabled by default and only appears if a personal account is already in use on the device.

Organisations that have previously restricted personal account usage with the DisablePersonalSync policy will not see the prompt. Administrators can also suppress it using the DisableNewAccountDetection policy.

Microsoft 365 Business Premium and Office 365 E1 grant discontinuation-Nonprofit

Microsoft announced on Wednesday, May 14, 2025, that the Microsoft 365 Business Premium grant and Office 365 E1 grant on CSP and Web Direct Channels will be discontinued for nonprofit customers upon their next renewal date on or after July 1, 2025.

To support nonprofits during this transition, Microsoft continues to offer:

- Up to 300 granted licenses of Microsoft 365 Business Basic
- Discounts up to 75 percent on many Microsoft 365 nonprofit offers, including Microsoft 365 Business Premium and Office 365 E1.
